Sidewalk Demo & Shrub Trimming on Your Corner (SW Portland Street & Highland Park Way)

WHAT'S HAPPENING

To increase safety and accessibility, we are rebuilding the sidewalk on the west side of Highland Park Way SW. You have probably noticed the sidewalk closure. As part of this work, we are replacing a portion of the sidewalk and installing an upgraded ADA ramp at the SW corner of SW Portland St and Highland Park Way SW, which is very near your home.


Thursday, September 7 or Friday, September 8.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Noise: Our crew will demolish the existing sidewalk using a chipping hammer, which is loud and generates vibrations. After the concrete is broken up, we will remove the debris, place rock and gravel, and use a plate compactor to create the foundation for the new sidewalk. The plate compactor is also quite noisy and generates vibrations as well, though it's not as disruptive as the chipping hammer.

Hedge Trimming: There are some hedges that have grown over the sidewalk (see the photo below). We will need to trim these back. Please contact us if you have questions. Our contact information is below.
