Especially Noisy Work Near Your Home: Highland Park Way SW & SW Holden St Safety Project

WHAT'S HAPPENING

As part of the Highland Park Way SW and SW Holden St Safety Project, we will be breaking up the existing concrete and pouring new concrete on SW Holden St.

WHEN

This work is scheduled for **Wednesday, September 20 and Monday, September 25**, but that may shift depending on weather and crew availability.

WHAT TO EXPECT

We will demolish the existing concrete using a chipping hammer, which is loud and generates vibrations. You will hear additional equipment as we rebuild the road and pour new concrete, but it will not be as loud as the demolition.

There will be lane closures during this time as well, but there will always be at least one lane open for traffic and we will have crew on site to guide traffic.
