










City of Seattle Heritage Tree Program

The Heritage Tree program, administered jointly by the Seattle Department of Transportation and Plant Amnesty, recognizes and celebrates noteworthy trees throughout Seattle. Trees on both public and private lands can be nominated based on the following categories:

SPECIMEN: A tree of exceptional size, form or rarity.

LANDMARK: Trees that are community landmarks.

COLLECTION: Several trees in a notable grove, avenue or planting.

HISTORIC: A tree recognized by virtue of its age, its association with an historic structure or district, or connection to a noted person or historic event.
