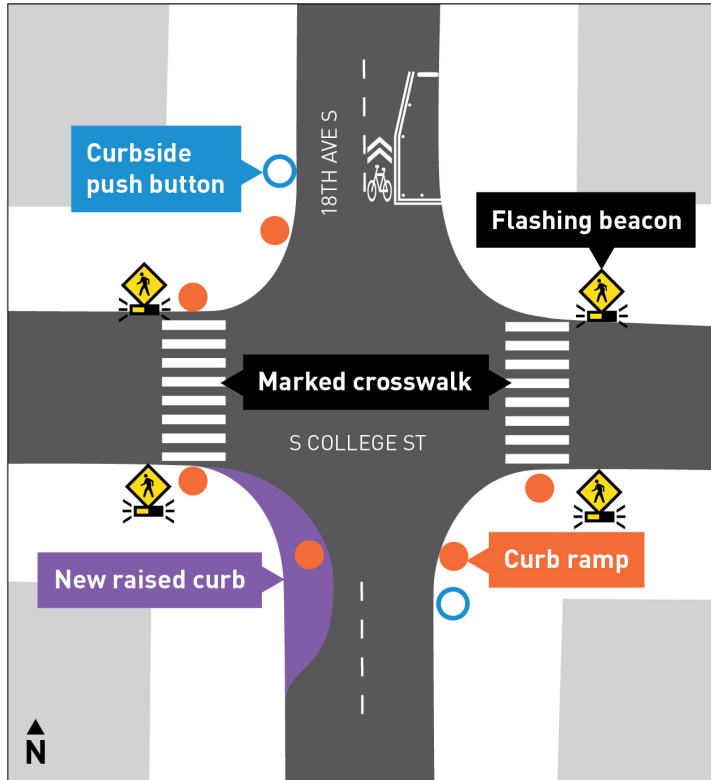


SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS COMING SOON!

Construction starting at S College St and 18th Ave S as soon as Jan. 26



Healthy Street Safety Enhancements

SDOT is beginning construction on the pedestrian and bike improvements planned for S College St and 18th Ave S. These improvements are part of the North Beacon Hill Healthy Street. The updates at this intersection include:

- New crossing lights (flashing beacons)
- New curbside push buttons for crossings
- New raised curb
- Marked crosswalks
- ADA accessible curb ramps
- Drainage and stormwater improvements (in coordination with Seattle Public Utilities)

What to Expect During Construction

- We anticipate SDOT and SPU crews to begin construction as soon as Friday, January 26, 2024.
- To minimize impacts as much as possible and due to challenging traffic controls at this tight intersection, **work will take place over 3 weekends of long work days.** Construction schedule is dependent on weather conditions.
- Work will cause noise and vibration. SDOT has received a noise variance for this work.
- There will be construction staging and parking impacts near the work site. We will place “No Parking” signs in advance of the closure.
- At times, there may be limited access through this intersection. There will be detours for people driving, walking, and rolling. Check our website for detour routes!
