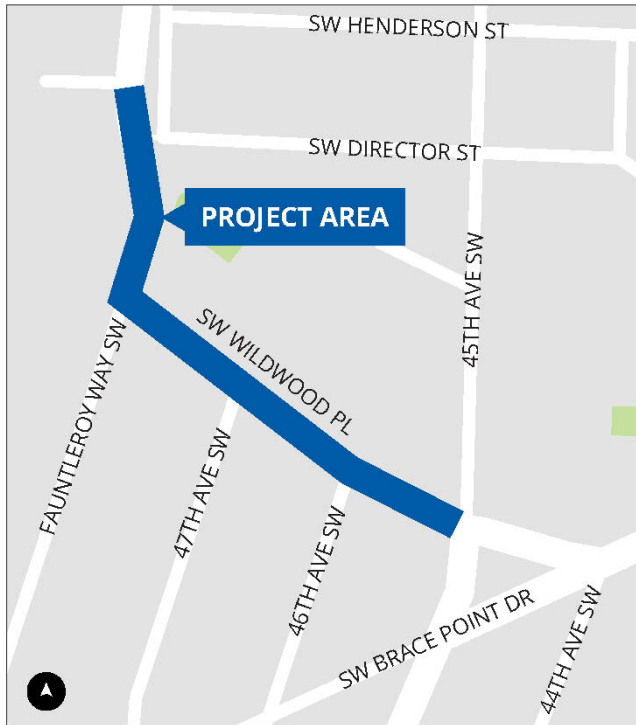


New Safety Features Coming to Fauntleroy Way SW and SW Wildwood Pl

What have we done so far?

Removed parking along Fauntleroy Way SW and SW Wildwood Pl between the Ferry Terminal and 46th Ave SW

What comes next?

We plan to:

- Install protected bike lanes
- Relocate load zones at 45th Ave SW and SW Wildwood Pl
- Relocate Passenger Drop-Off locations south of the ferry terminal

What can you expect during construction?

- Temporary lane closure
- Temporary restricted access to some driveways
- Loud noise and dust
- Vibrations from machinery
- Construction equipment in the area

Why a Protected Bike Lane?

To improve safety, we are considering two options:

- Option 1:
 - A protected bike lane for uphill/southbound bikes
 - Bike and cars will maintain a shared downhill general purpose travel lane going north toward Fauntleroy Ferry Terminal2
- Option 2:
 - Two protected bike lanes on either side of SW Wildwood Pl and Fauntleroy Way SW for uphill and downhill (northbound and southbound) lanes

When will this work be complete?

The initial phase of construction has been completed, with paint and posts now installed to temporarily restrict parking.

The bike lane will be installed by the end of 2026. Thank you for your patience. When we finish construction, your community, will be safer for everyone to walk, drive, bike, and roll.
