

City of Seattle Public Utilities Notice of Rulemaking

Under the authority of the Seattle Municipal Code 3.02 and 3.32.020, Seattle Public Utilities proposes a new Director's Rule, WTR-620, Code of Conduct for Visitors at the Cedar River Watershed Education Center and Associated Programs. We invite the public's review and comment.

Director's Rule WTR-620 would establish a code of conduct for visitors at the Cedar River Watershed Education Center and associated programs on watershed premises to ensure that all users may have the opportunity to benefit from the facilities and programs the Watershed offers. The scope of the rule would apply to all property and facilities that are accessed by the Cedar River Watershed educational programs operated by Seattle Public Utilities.
