



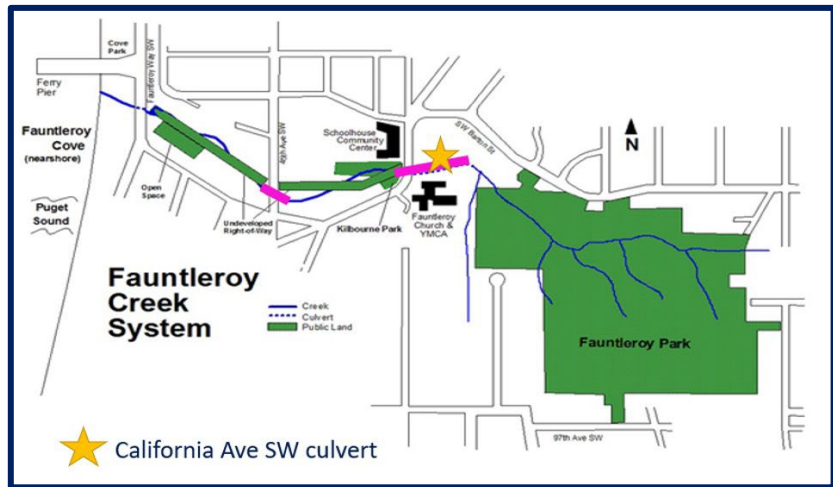
California Culvert Replacement Project

Project goal

The existing culvert on Fauntleroy Creek at California Ave SW is in poor condition and being prioritized for replacement as part of SPU’s Culvert Program. The existing culvert is approximately 380-feet and spans both public right-of-way and nearby private property. The project will replace the existing culvert with a fish passable structure and will incorporate stream channel restoration up and downstream of the proposed structure, along with streetscape improvements to improve access, visibility, and promote stewardship of the creek and accompanying fish and wildlife habitats.

Project location

The culvert at California Ave SW on Fauntleroy Creek is part of the Fauntleroy neighborhood in West Seattle. The creek runs from nearby Fauntleroy Park west to the Puget Sound.
