Building natural drainage systems in Crown Hill to reduce street flooding and sewer problems



Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is planning a project on 17th Ave NW between NW 85th St and NW 90th St. This project will combine natural drainage systems and pipe upgrades to reduce street flooding and the risk of sewer backups to nearby homes. It will also include sidewalk improvements, traffic calming measures, and new drainage infrastructure on NW 85th St and NW 90th St.

Based on previous neighborhood planning and community engagement, SPU has developed two possible design concepts for the street and drainage improvements. Your input will help select a preferred alternative to move forward for design and construction.



Natural drainage systems use plants and special soils to improve drainage and water quality. This image shows one possible concept for improvements on 17th Ave NW.
