Single-family homes: Submit a request online or call (206) 684-3000

Apartment & multifamily residents: Contact the building manager/owner.

Batteries: \$5 for up to 2 1-gallon plastic bags of household batteries. **Electronics:** \$20 for as many items that fit in a 2'x2'x2' box. Items larger than 2 ft: \$30
