

## Notes for DOH Water Use Efficiency Rule Op Board Update 1/28/09

Looking at the matrix/schedule:

- 1) Conservation Goal – Done. Each utility adopted the regional goal. Just repeat the Date of Public Forum you used last year.

The Annual Report form now distinguishes supply-side goals (which are optional) and demand-side goals (required). The 1% Program goal is a demand-side goal.

- 2) Total Annual Production - DOH still needs your Total Production by July 1. SPU needs you to **fill out the Annual Survey by End of February** so we can calculate conservation program savings.
- 3) DSL – Essentially same as last year. Guidebook attempts to clarify elements of Authorized Consumption and Distribution System Leakage. Must enter info in gallons; form may calculate it for you. The SPU annual survey still has optional columns to help you calculate DSL.
- 4) Conservation Program Narrative and Results – SPU will provide:
  - Individual rebate reports (e.g. all the WashWise rebates that took place in a district) by end of Feb.
  - Final narrative and numbers for regional reporting by April 1.
  - Sample DOH Annual Report Form filled out with regional info by April 1.

Looking at the Annual Report Form,

Here's a note for Pg 4, 1st bullet:

We have sometimes stated our goal as 'keep demand flat' at 2000 levels. Just to clarify, we are indeed making a reduction in per capita use, because we are absorbing population growth from 2000-2010. The "1%" in the program title refers to a 1% reduction in per capita use. (And certainly the graphs show a drop in per capita consumption from 2000 to today.)
