



Ridership Year-over-Year Change




Regional Partnership Routes






On-Time Performance






RapidRide Performance

Vehicle License Fee Rebate


- Issued 4,909 rebate cards in Year 1
- 2016 Goal: Issue 5,000 rebate cards
 - Reached 62% of goal as of June 30, 2016
- 2017 Goal: Issue 5,750 rebate cards

ORCA LIFT Enrollment

- Approximately 173,000
 Seattle residents are eligible for ORCA LIFT (26.7% of total population)
 - 18,600 Seattle residents
 enrolled through June 30,
 2016 (11%)
- Expansion efforts with Department of Neighborhoods





Youth ORCA

- February 2016 Start Date
 - Partnership with Seattle Public Schools
 - Started in middle of school year
 - 300 ORCA Cards issued
- Revisions for 2016-17 School Year
 - 3,000 ORCA Cards available
 - Working directly with schools
 - Actively engaging students at school events
 - Approximately 1,000 cards issued to date
