

Species Composition UTRP Trees Planted in Rainier Beach





TREE PRESERVATION DURING WABASH SUBSTATION SOIL REMEDiation




FORMER WABASH SUBSTATION FEB 10-24, 2014

- SCL Develops Process to Preserve Trees during Site Remediation
- Air spade loosens soil from roots
- Soil vactored around roots
- Backfilled excavated soil



RESTORING TRANSMISSION LINE CORRIDORS

- The Environmental Leadership Initiative (CR8) pilot study to establish low growing, diverse, native plant communities
- Pilot study to determine effective methods for reducing the cover of invasive plants and increase low growing native vegetation to suppress undesirable plants and improve habitat conditions in transmission corridors

Creston-Duwamish Transmission Line






Bangor Site
