Lifetime Dianne Laurine Achievement

<u>Award</u>: This lifetime achievement award is given to a person with a disability who has demonstrated a long-term commitment to breaking the barriers that impede people with

disabilities and through this advocacy has significantly advanced the rights of Seattleites with disabilities.

Eligibility Criteria: Nominees should include individuals who have dedicated their careers to making major contributions to the improvement of health, accessibility, and the quality of life for people with disabilities through research, teaching, advocacy, or practice and who have been locally, nationally and/or internationally recognized for their work.

Business Leader Award: This award is given to a business or organization that has made a significant contribution to advancing the rights and/or lives of people with disabilities in Seattle. The advancement may come in many ways including progressive employment practices, technological advances, and anti-stigma policies and practices.

Eligibility Criteria: Nominees must demonstrate ability, advocacy, access, or achievements in Seattle; Recognize inclusion and commitment of people with disabilities; Business must conduct business or be located in Seattle, WA.
