Proposed Art Plan for New Seattle Arena

As outlined in the MOU between OVG and the City of Seattle (9/12/17), The Seattle City Office of Arts & Culture (ARTS) will work with OVG, OED, Seattle Center, and other City departments to facilitate the investment of one percent (1%) of the Arena's capital construction costs into the renovated Arena and the cultural ecology of the Seattle Center/Uptown Arts and Cultural District.

The funds will be invested in art in a two-phase process:

- Phase I: Creation of Site-Specific Permanent Art Objects (2017-2020)
 - A portion of the funds will be invested in permanently sited work(s) of public art, created specifically for the Arena.
 - OVG will select a Design Team Artist to work collaboratively with the design team to determine locations within the project site and make suggestions for integrated art.
- Phase II: Investment in the Uptown Arts and Cultural District (2020 onward)
 - A portion of the funds will be invested in publicly accessible art events and objects throughout the Uptown community.
 - OVG will work collaboratively with the Uptown Arts and Culture Coalition (UACC) board and the Seattle Office of Arts and Culture (ARTS) to determine the best opportunities for investment.
