- Lighting
- Security Window Film
- Window Planters
- Laminated Glass "Shatter-proof" Window
- Repair of existing awning or new storefront awning
- Business and Wayfinding Signs (Open, Close, Enter, Exit, Operating Hours).
- Address Labeling
- Defensive Landscaping Near Access Points. (Rose / Holly Bushes)
- Permitted street planters. See <u>street furniture guidelines</u>.
- Scissor gate
- Window Folding Security Gate
- Deadbolts
- Window Locks
- Alarm systems (equipment only, not monitoring services, and not including security cameras)
- Temporary window or door board up
- Window repair or replacement
- Door repair or replacement
- Gate repair or replacement

Ineligible expenses

- Graffiti removal
- Purchase of security cameras
- Reimbursement for security personnel
- Loss of stolen goods/services
