City Attorney Drops Charges Against Naked Bike Rider

The Seattle City Attorney's Office today dropped charges against the organizer of the World Naked Bike Ride.

Daniel Johnson was charged on December with indecent exposure after Seattle Police received complaints from people offended by the dozen or so cyclists riding through West Seattle in September, the day of the World Naked Bike Ride.

Some who complained said they were especially concerned because children were around when the bicycle group stopped at Lincoln Park.

The charge was dismissed "in the interest of justice."
