Council President Nelson,

On January 6, 2024, you and the mayor sent City Auditor David Jones a letter requesting that his office update their 2012 assessment of City-funded crime prevention projects and prepare to review the Technology Assisted Crime Prevention Pilot Project. Through this email, I want to update you on the status of these two projects.

We have asked the City Auditor to pause updating the crime prevention assessment because HSD is preparing to issue a new round of RFPs that will result in new funding opportunities. Assessing these programs in the context of the RFP responses seems more prudent.

The technology pilot project will shift to the Office of the Inspector General for Public Safety. IG Judge has agreed to facilitate an implementation and outcome evaluation of these technologies by retaining academic subject matter experts who have completed similar reviews for other cities. This project remains on course.
