How to Prepare your Heating Oil Tax Return

Column B: Enter the total gallons of Heating Oil sold at retail within the City.

Column C: Enter your deduction of the total gallons of Biodiesel (or gallons of Biodiesel within a blend) sold at retail within the City.

Column D: Subtract the amount in column C from the amount in column B and enter the result in column D

Column F: Multiply the amount in column D by the tax rate shown in Column E and enter the result in Column F.

Online Reporting

This form can be filed online at <u>www.filelocal-wa.gov</u>. Account registration and electronic payment are required to file online. Tax form setup might be required when you file your first form. The form type, period, and frequency can be found on the front of this form.

Report by Mail

Make check payable to **City of Seattle**. Payments must be sent with the tax return when tax is due. Forms received without payment will not t considered "received" if taxes are owed. Late penalties and interest shall apply if either the form or check are postmarked after the due date.

Late Penalties

A return showing any tax due must be received by the due date to avoid late penalty. If received after the due date, penalty shall apply as following Nine percent (9%) of the tax due if postmarked after the due date; or

Nineteen percent (19%) of the tax due if postmarked after the last day of the month following the due date; or Twenty-nine percent (29%) of the tax due if postmarked after the last day of the second month following the due date.

If there is no tax due, no late fee will be charged. When tax is due, the minimum penalty will be \$5.00. Interest will be calculated from the date tax is due until the date paid. If the total due is not paid in full, the City will send a notice of underpayment for the additional balance ower
