## **CPC Reviewing Monitor's Compliance Report**

Seattle---The CPC is reviewing the Monitor's compliance report. The Commission supports the DOJ's request to extend the briefing deadlines and proposed briefing schedule. The CPC must have sufficient time to allow for a full discussion on this report in a public Commission meeting before we formally respond to the Monitor's views. The Seattle Police Department has made significant strides in the five years since the start of the federal court process. Our attention is focused on performing the oversight the community expects from us and on ensuring that Seattle's new oversight structure is fully funded, implemented, and staffed as soon as possible so that the city is ready when federal supervision concludes. The CPC will continue to protect the community's essential role in reforms.
