NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CORRECT AND CLARIFY LAND USE AND RELATED CODE LANGUAGE (LAND USE CODE OMNIBUS BILL)

The Seattle City Council is considering amendments to the Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) to correct typographical errors, modify cross references, clarify regulations, and make minor amendments to the Land Use Code (SMC Title 23), the Rental Registration and Inspection Ordinance (SMC Chapter 22.214), and the Critical Areas Ordinance (SMC Chapter 25.05). This bill is sometimes referred to as the Land Use Code Omnibus.

PUBLIC HEARING

The City Council's Land Use and Neighborhoods Committee will hold a public hearing on the legislation on Wednesday, June 24 at 9:30 AM.
