INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTERPRETERS WORKING IN KING COUNTY JAIL COURTROOM #2 (KCJ2)

ARRIVAL

- 1. KCJ2 is located INSIDE the King County Jail at 500 5th Ave across from the Seattle Municipal Court.
- 2. You will need to go through security and you're NOT allowed to take your phone inside.
- 3. Show your interpreter ID to the guard and sign in, if you wish to leave your phone in a free locker.
- 4. Once in, turn to the right and walk to Courtroom 2 (KCJ2) on your right.
- 5. Knock on the door for admittance.

CHECK-IN

- 1. Check in with the bailiffs seated along the right wall. Invoices are in the box on the wall above the bailiffs.
- 2. Let the marshal and the defense attorney know you're available.
- 3. Find equipment in the narrow room to the left from the marshals.
- 4. Equipment will be plugged into charger, with headpieces in a bag.
- 5. Clean and assemble equipment (attach microphone to transmitter, headphones to receiver see instructions on the wall).
- 6. Make sure the channel marked on the unit matches the channel on the dial.
- 7. To turn ON the receiver (unit for the listener/defendant), turn the volume button.
- 8. To turn ON the transmitter (your unit), press down the on/off button and hold until it turns green. Make sure you don't change the channel on your unit!
- 9. Check to make sure both units are working.
- 10. Never take equipment to the lock up area!!!
- 11. Ask marshal for assistance if you cannot get equipment working properly.

3-STEPS OF INTERPRETING

- 1. Attorney and you will walk into a lock-up area for an attorney-client interview.
 - a. No equipment is needed for this step.
 - b. After the initial attorney-client interview, exit with the attorney back into the courtroom to wait for a hearing.
- 2. Guard will bring the defendant out to the glass partition for court hearing.
 - c. Do NOT step into secure area behind the glass partition with the defendant, <u>stay outside and use</u> <u>the equipment!</u>
 - d. Hand receiver with headphones over to the defendant, indicate volume button, and check if the defendant can hear you OK.
 - e. Place yourself in the area between the defendant and the Judge, facing defense and city attorneys.
 - f. If you cannot interpret simultaneously, inform the court so they do the hearing in consecutive mode.
 - g. Once the hearing is over, continue waiting in the courtroom for the bailiff.
 - h. The Guard will send the defendant back into the lockup area, but the case is not over!
 - i. **Turn off** the equipment and disassemble.
 - j. Wipe down with Sani-wipes, and place both units into the charger.
 - k. Make sure both lights on the base are lit, showing that the units are charging.
 - I. If lights are not showing, reverse unit's position (180°) to align with the charger.
- 3. Bailiff will go over paperwork with the defendant.
 - a. No equipment is needed for this step.
 - b. Stand alongside bailiff and interpret from outside of glass partition.

CHECK-OUT

- 1. Confirm with the bailiff that you are no longer needed and have them sign your invoice.
- 2. Make sure to pick up your phone and any items locked up on your way out!
