## ELECTION CALENDAR

- Nov. 9-13** Submit Candidacy Declaration form to City Clerk
- Nov. 13** Deadline for submitting Candidacy Declarations form to City clerk by 5:00 p.m.
- Nov. 18** Deadline for candidates to submit voter pamphlet statement and photo to City Clerk by 5:00 p.m.
- Dec. 4** Ballots, instructions and voter pamphlet are mailed to eligible employee voters' homes.
- Dec. 14-18\*** Election week: Marked ballots will be accepted by the City Clerk
- Dec. 18\*** Deadline for submittal of ballots to the City Clerk, 5:00 p.m. Ballots mailed by US Mail, must be postmarked by 12:00 midnight on December 18, 2020
- Dec. 21** Ballot tabulation begins
- Dec. 30** or earlier: City Clerk certifies results of elections
- Dec. 30** or earlier: City Clerk notifies all candidates of the results
