## 1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

 February 24, 2020 -Special Meeting: The Commission reviewed the minutes of the February 24, 2020 Special Meeting of the CSC. Commissioner Davis moved to accept the minutes as written, Commissioner Wideman-Williams seconded the motion. The minutes were approved by acclamation and signed by the chair.

- 2. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT
- a. COVID-19 Update: COOP: Ms. Scheele updated the commission on the City-Wide Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP). COOP identifies where the City will direct its limited resources during a pandemic to the highest priority essential functions. An Essential Function is either a Priority Service One (1) or Priority Service Two (2) function. The CSC does not have priority 1 or 2 service functions, whereas the PSCSC has several priority two functions. Therefore, staff has been keeping up to date City leadership, particularly regarding Fire and Police Exams. PPE: Ms. Scheele also informed the Commission that City departments are working on providing PPE for employees returning to or currently working in city buildings. Grievances: A Memorandum of Understanding is being proposed to the Collective Bargaining Unions to extend filing deadlines for grievances.
- **b. Executive Director Council Confirmation Update:** Ms. Scheele informed the commission that she will be confirmed by the City Council on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- c. Budget Update: Departments were requested to submit line items for proposed budget cuts. Ms. Scheele submitted travel and training. The City Budget Office accepted the submission.
- **d. Financial Interest Statements Update:** All commissioners returned their signed FIS. Civil Service Commission is 100% compliant.
- 3. CASE STATUS REPORT/APPEALS UPDATE: There are no new appeals.
- **4.** OLD/NEW BUSINESS: No Old/New business.

**ADJOURN:** All other business before the Commission having been considered, Commission Chair Bonfrisco adjourned the meeting at approximately 2:42 pm
