1	Question: An electronic submission has to be via email? And what if the file is too large, do you not accept an invitation to a shared site from which you can download the application? Are multiple emails acceptable?	Answer: In the past, we have had large files shared to us via Dropbox or other applications. Make sure to be very clear that an attachment is coming and if there is a password or authentication process to please include that in the application. 1	Question: If the Preschool Operators a SPP designated preschool provider and planning to lease the space in the new building once construction, estimated start of construction March 2022, is that permissible. With the DEEL funds coming to the provider at licensing as a capitalized lease payment.	Answer: See minimum site control requirements in the RFI on pages 8-9, successful proposals distribute funds through an award contract.	Date Answered: 7/6/21
2	Question: Does the lease need to be included with the application, and if yes, does DEEL provide a template for the lease you prefer?	Answer: Yes, the lease does need to be included in the application. No, we do not provide a template for the lease.	Date Answered: 7/7/21

5	Question: 10% hard cost contingency is very typical for new construction space. Is there a reason that you require 15%?	Answer: This is from our legal reviews, DEEL has historically asked for 15% as directed by our legal and financial team.	Date Answered: 7/7/21
6	Question: Your proposal requirements have some obstacles and barriers for high-quality well-designed space to be part of a mixed-use building that includes affordable housing developed through the LIHTC program. Is this intentional with your preference for stand-alone preschools owned by SPP providers rather than participants and lessees in mixed use buildings serving low-income households?	Answer: SPP providers both in stand alone and mixed use facilities are eligible to apply for these funds.	Date Answered: 7/7/21
7	Question: Is a letter of interest for a lease, okay? It is hard to commit a 15-year lease without funding support to finish project.	Answer: Please refer to page 8 for our list of acceptable control requirements and commitments.	Date Answered: 7/7/21

Topic: Budget			
1	Question: Would you be likely to provide a \$1,000,000 award for new construction of a 6-classroom Early Learning Center in a new affordable housing development? This would use nearly the entire allocation you have available;	Answer: Awards depend on the applicant pool and scores based on the panel's review. This is a competitive grant process, there is no guarantee that any proposals will receive funding. The City reserves the right to reject all proposals and the right to negotiate with an agency or provider as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regarding the amount of funding to be provided; this may differ from the amount requested in the proposal • Terms or conditions of awards resulting from this RFI process The program can only fund pre-K classrooms and related spaces. The funding application has to come from a current SPP or SPP Pathway provider.	Date Answered: 7/6/21



2	Question: The paper application says 15 years lease for over \$500,000 dollars. The slide said 20 years. Which is correct?	Answer: Minimum lease terms include: For awards above \$500,000, a minimum of twenty (20) years remaining on the current lease with the property owner.	Date Answered: 7/7/21
3	Question: Is match 50% also apply to award of \$1,000,000 dollars? That is for any award amount higher than \$500,000 dollars?	Answer: That is correct. Any award higher than \$250,000 dollars is still a 50% match. So, if you are requesting \$1,000,000 dollars, then we would expect to see \$500,000 dollars as a fund match from other sources.	Date Answered: 7/7/21
4	Question: If the preschool provider is leasing space that is completed and the DEEL funds are used for a capitalized lease payments, would this not be construed as construction funding?	Answer: This can be identified as part of the construction funding. However, keep in mind that this is a competitive process and awards are not guaranteed.	Date Answered: 7/7/21
5	Question: Is this a grant or a loan that needs to be paid back later on?	Answer: This is a grant and so in exchange we ask for a service commitment.	Date Answered: 7/7/21
