#	Question	Answer	Date Posted
1	<b>Must all levy targeted summer students attend or be enrolled in levy approved/targeted schools?</b>	No; there are no specific levy “approved/targeted” schools for Levy-funded summer learning. Levy-funded summer learning programs may serve all Seattle Public Schools students that match any of the focus student attributes listed on page three of each Summer Learning RFI.	11/1/2013
2	<b>Will a provider be penalized for recruiting students who meet levy requirements while partnering with a community center or other locations other than levy approved schools?</b>	There are no “approved” schools for Levy-funded summer learning, though all focus students must be enrolled to attend Seattle Public Schools. Partnerships will be assessed using the rating criteria outlined on pages 6-8 of each Summer Learning RFI.	11/1/2013
3	<b>May applicants target specific subgroups, (i.e., Refugees, ELL, Special Education, Black, Hispanic, Southeast Asian, Reading, Math, Science etc.)?</b>	Yes, applicants may focus recruiting on specific student subgroups. While summer learning program focus students should meet the academic criteria on page 3 of each RFI, Levy investments have a “particular focus on closing the achievement gap for low-income students, students of color, and English Language Learners,” as noted on page 2 of each RFI.	11/1/2013
4	<b>Is the following an acceptable method of denoting pay v FTE "10% pre-program planning, 65% during, up to 25% performance after summer?"</b>	Yes. There is no single "acceptable," method for explaining how staff time and funding will be allocated in program budgets.	11/1/2013
