

Vehicle Temporary Use Agreement

City of Seattle – Consumer Protection Division
King County – Records and Licensing Services Division



Overview

A driver operating a single taxicab on an irregular basis for a single owner or a single regional dispatch agency shall complete and sign a (vehicle) Temporary Use Agreement (this form) and keep it in the vehicle while operating and provide it to the Director upon request. The driver does not need to file a signed agreement with the Director.

Per [Seattle Rule FOR-HIRE-TRANSPORTATION-16-2024](#) and [King County Rule FHT-15-2024-PR](#), operating a single taxicab on an irregular basis shall meet the following requirements:

- The driver shall have a valid regional for-hire driver’s license;
- The driver shall operate the vehicle no more than a total of thirty (30) days per calendar year;
- The driver shall not be excluded from the insurance policy for the vehicle; and
- The vehicle shall be equipped with and operate a smart taximeter.
