NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

The Director of Finance, acting under the authority of Seattle Municipal Code Chapters 3.02 and 5.55, proposes to adopt new rules for implementing the Seattle Business License Tax Ordinances (Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 5.45). Please note that although these rules are applicable to SMC 5.45, the individual rules may also apply to other chapters of the City's Tax Code, including but not limited to, SMC 5.30 (Definitions), SMC 5.32 (Revenue Code), SMC 5.35 (Commercial Parking Tax), SMC 5.40 (Admissions Tax), SMC 5.48 (Business Tax – Utilities), SMC 5.52 (Gambling Tax), and SMC 5.55 (General Administrative Provisions). The following rules are proposed for adoption or amendment and will become effective as of January 1, 2020:
