OED IS HIRING A BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA ADVOCATE



CONGRESS MOVES TO CURB TICKET SCALPING, BANS ONLINE TICKETING BOTS

Last week the House of Representatives passed the "Better Online Ticket Sales Act," a bill which makes it illegal to circumvent security measures on ticketing websites. Use of ticketing bots often allows for high-priced ticket resales, pushing many events out of financial reach for ordinary consumers.




LOCALLY FILMED "CAPTAIN FANTASTIC" NOMINATED FOR A GOLDEN GLOBE
