

The Rainier Ave S and I-90 Metro Stairs encampment clean up was conducted at the same time as the I-90 Cloverleaf Litter Pick. The Cloverleaf had approximately 22 tents and 2 large structures at time of inspection on 04/05/17.

The scope of work for the litter pick was -

- Move the campers away from the street and I-90 Exit to Rainier
- Create a work zone in the Cloverleaf (see map) to safely remove debris from the site

Many of the campers who were at the Rainier/I-90 Metro Stairs encampment, moved to the I-90 Cloverleaf. At the close of the Metro Stairs clean up, the I-90 Cloverleaf had 30 tents and 7 large structures (45-50 people).
