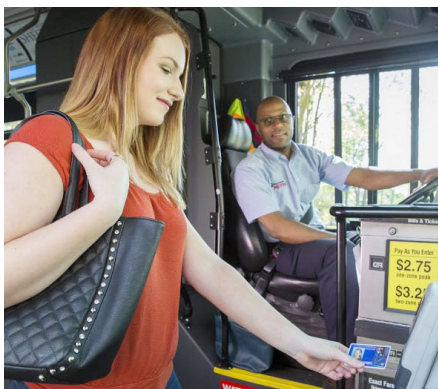




Employee Commute Options Program

ORCA CARD

Most City of Seattle employees are eligible for an ORCA Card that covers:

- 100% full fare on all land-based transit, King County Water Taxi, and Kitsap Fast Ferry service.
- Up to \$99 per month for WA State passenger-only Ferry pass and for Vanpool. NEW: 100% subsidy coverage in 2022.

Important ORCA Passport info

- Your ORCA Passport card will automatically renew every year!
- TAP ON / TAP OFF – for Light Rail and Sounder Commuter Rail.

How do I get the ORCA Card?

- In person: Visit the Treasury Operations office, Seattle Municipal Tower, 42nd floor, or the 4th floor lobby customer service counter, M-F from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. to get your ORCA Passport.
- *If you are unable to come in person, a co-worker can pick up the card for you. Contact MyTrips for details.

Online: You can sign up for (and make changes to) your ORCA Passport through Employee Self Service (ESS).

GUARANTEED RIDE HOME

If you regularly commute to work by transit, ferry, vanpool, carpool, bike or walk, then you are eligible for the Guaranteed Ride Home—a reimbursable taxi ride home:

- If you become sick and must go home or to the doctor and no transit option is available.
- If a family member has a medical emergency and your presence is required.
- Unscheduled emergency overtime with your supervisor or manager's approval.
- Missed carpool or vanpool if driver had to leave early for an emergency.

VANPOOL & VAN SHARE

Save Time, Save Money!

Vanpool

- 5-15 commuters who ride to work 3 – 5 days per week in a van provided by a transit agency.
- Follows a schedule and route set by the riders themselves.
- One monthly fare pays for gas, insurance, and maintenance.
- Your ORCA card pays up to \$99 per month toward monthly van fare. NEW: 100% subsidy coverage in 2022.
- Plus, you can still ride transit in addition to your vanpool.

Van Share is like having your own private shuttle connection. See the MyTrips page for details.
