I am pleased to announce the availability of up to \$111,686 of Seattle Sweetened Beverage Tax (SBT) funding for the 2020 Geographic Specific – Delridge, Georgetown, South Park - Food Bank Services Request for Proposal (RFP). Funding awards will be made for the period of July 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. Contracts after the initial period will be contingent upon successful performance and funding availability, with \$223,372 available in subsequent years to support year-round work for a contract period of January-December.
