Application: Proposed seismic upgrades.

Staff Report: Heather McAuliffe distributed exhibits from the application. The relevant guidelines were 2 and 7.

Applicant Comment: Laurie Lohrer, building owner, said that the building was built in 1905 and that her husband's business, Dock Street Brokers, has been in

the building for 40 years. She said that the previous owners from whom they bought the building in 1998 had been responsible for starting the preservation efforts for the District in the 70s. She explained that she and her husband were able to get 25% of the funding for the seismic upgrade paid for through a grant from 4Culture. She said she hoped the work would begin August 1 and that it would last through the end of October. Part of the work involves replacing the roof. She said the solar panels on the roof would be relocated temporarily to the annex building during construction.

Andrew Phillips, project architect, explained that K braces would be installed behind the storefront and upper story windows facing Ballard Avenue. Plates will be installed on the two non-primary facades but that the primary facades would just be epoxied. He went through several other options that were considered for the seismic upgrade. He said that the K braces will be 1'9" back from the windows and will be painted black. The plates on the non-primary facades will be painted brown to match the brick.

Public Comment: There were no comments from the public.

Board Discussion: Board members concurred that the application met Guidelines 2 f. and 7.

Motion: Brian van Stipdonk made a motion to approve the application as presented.
