Choice Produce operates as a produce stand selling fresh produce. Situated in a high-traffic area on Pike Pl., Mr. Ha frequently receives requests for water from Pike Place Market patrons. Despite not being permitted to sell water currently, he generously gives away bottled water for free due to overwhelming demand. In light of this popularity, Mr. Ha seeks permission to sell bottled water at his produce stand.

Additionally, Mr. Lee is a respected member of the community and in good standing with the PDA.
