

Survey of Current Conditions

The Downtown Seattle Association (DSA) is currently under contract with Seattle Parks and Recreation to manage and activate Occidental Square Park. In accordance with that agreement one of the ways DSA is tasked with managing and activating the space for public use and enjoyment. Current conditions are light and underused. As part of Club World Cup programming DSA is proposing to bring a 30x60 soccer pitch for free public use for a limited duration of time (Installation on June 14th with removal on September 6th).

Proposed Installation Dimensions

Footprint for proposed soccer pitch installation is a 30 ft x 60 ft area

Dimensions

- 10 red wooden borders (length), each measuring 12 feet
- 2 red wooden borders (width), each measuring 14 feet 9 inches
- Turf soccer pitch measuring 60 feet by 30 feet
- 2 accessible yellow entry points, each measuring 5 feet by 15 feet, located on each length side

1. **Tripping Hazards:** The borders are painted bright red to improve visibility and help prevent tripping.

2. **Cleaning:** The turf can be clean by regularly removing debris. While it was on the Pier, it was maintained through raking, brushing, light pressure washing, spot cleaning, and using a leaf blower or shop vacuum.
