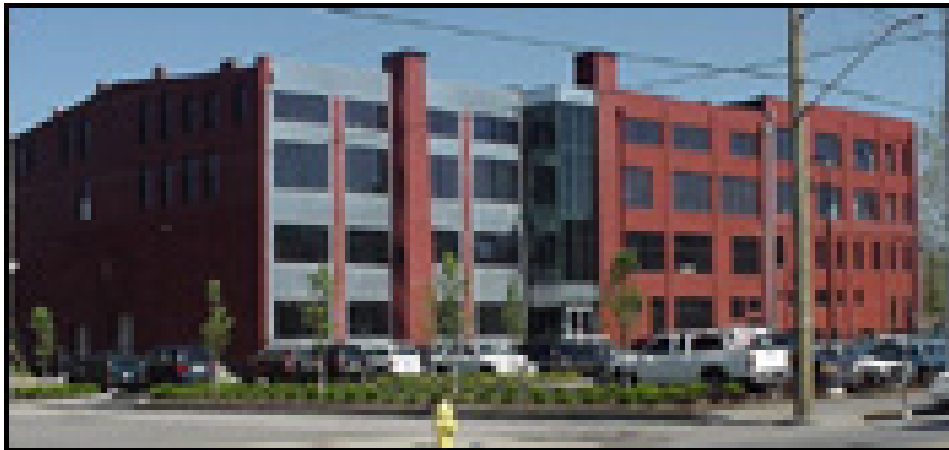

“Boyd Tavern is not illustrative of some idealized historical model but is instead a wonderful example how buildings in the real world actually evolve over a period of many years. Additions were built and removed, architectural elements were recycled or reclaimed from other buildings, windows were closed up, doors were cut into existing walls, roofs were removed, stories added, and on and on until you have what you have today. Not the shining vision of some long ago master carpenter, but a wonderful, rambling, marvel of a building whose history can be seen in each mismatched mantle and door frame. The focus of this renovation project has been to shore up, repair, paint, and weatherproof as necessary to preserve the structure, but never to obscure the spontaneity and sense of adventure that truly make Boyd Tavern a unique historical and architectural treasure.”
