

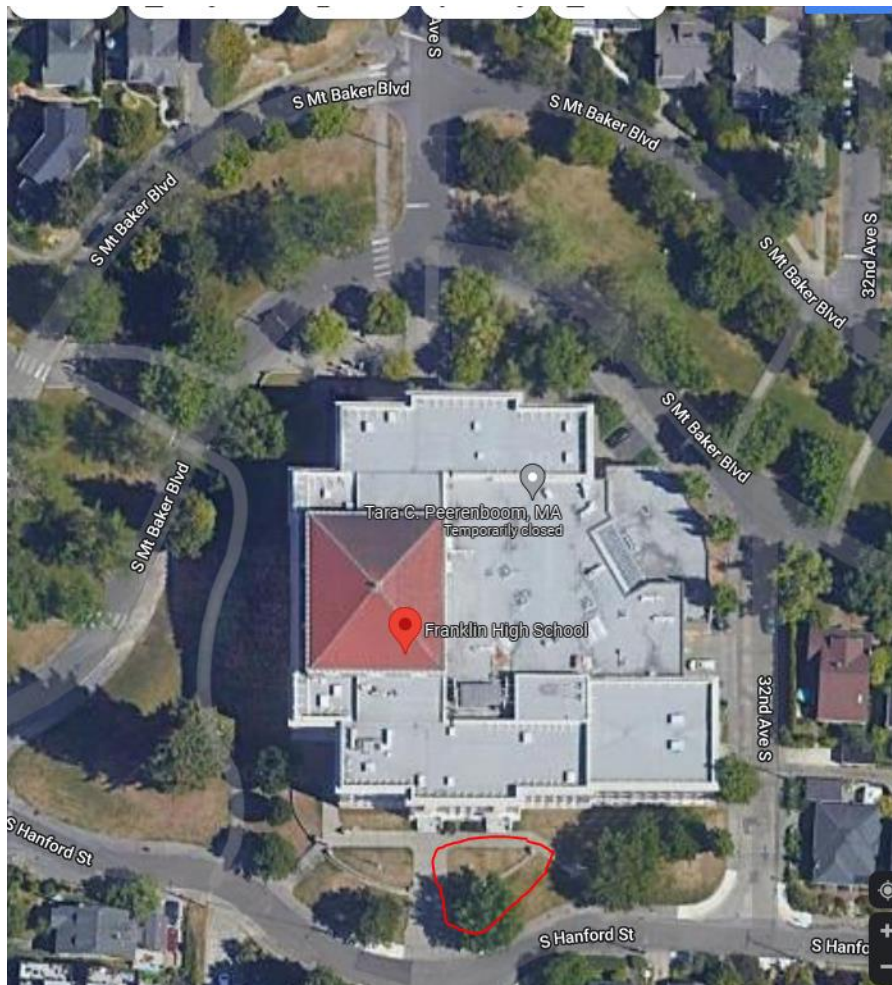

Earth Corps Garden Establishment Project

Establish two garden boxes on the South Lawn at Franklin Highschool to be built, and maintained in agreement with the Woodshop class, Garden Club and Earth Corps club.

The most suitable location for a successful garden is on the south lawn. This area receives plenty of sunshine and has access to water. The woodshop will construct two Cedar garden beds measuring 4'Wx8'L and standing 18"-24" above the ground.

AERIAL VIEW OF SITE



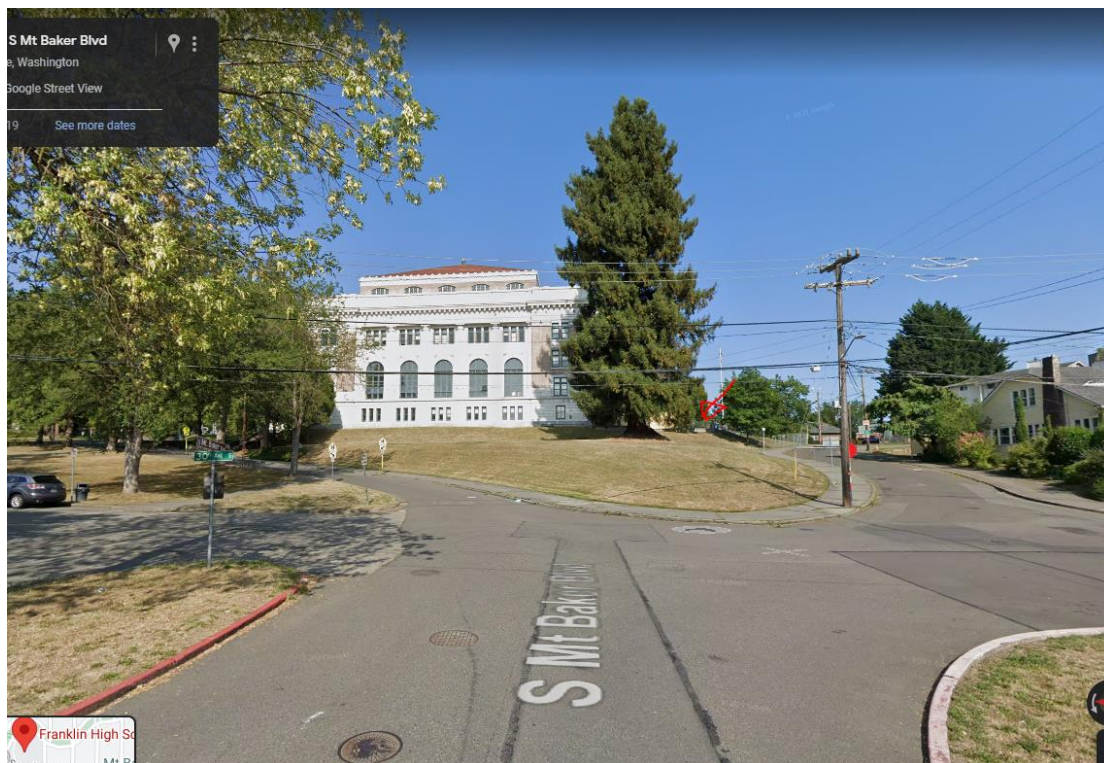
South Entrance to School

Garden boxes marked in red, they will be on this slightly elevated tier of lawn.



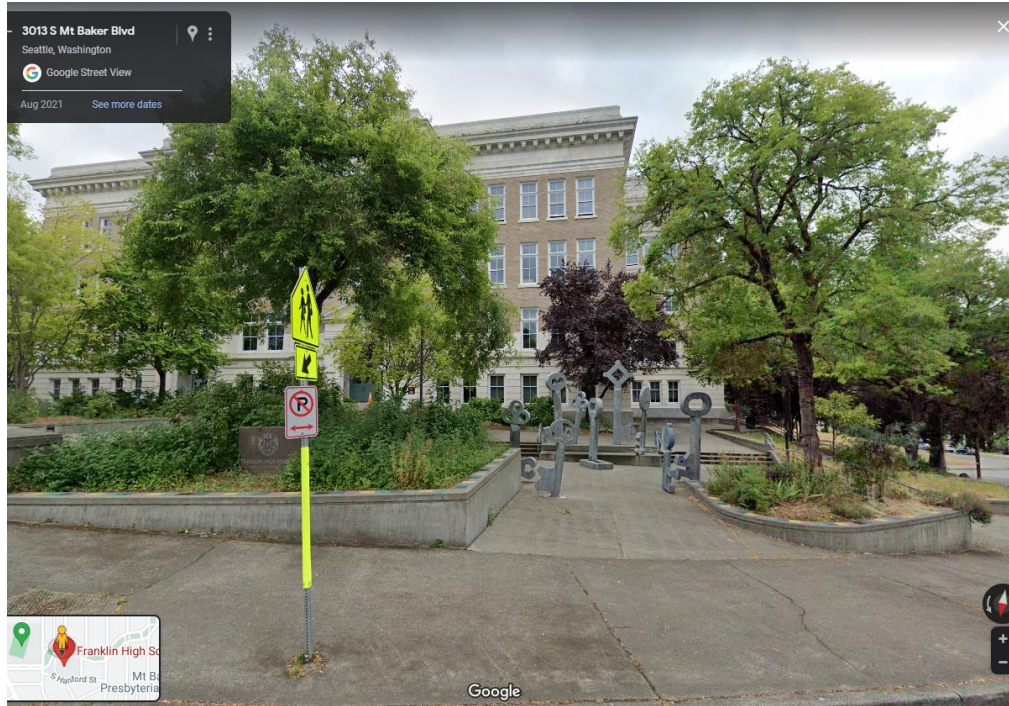
View of West face of school.

Observer is facing east. Future garden beds would be located just east of flagpole.



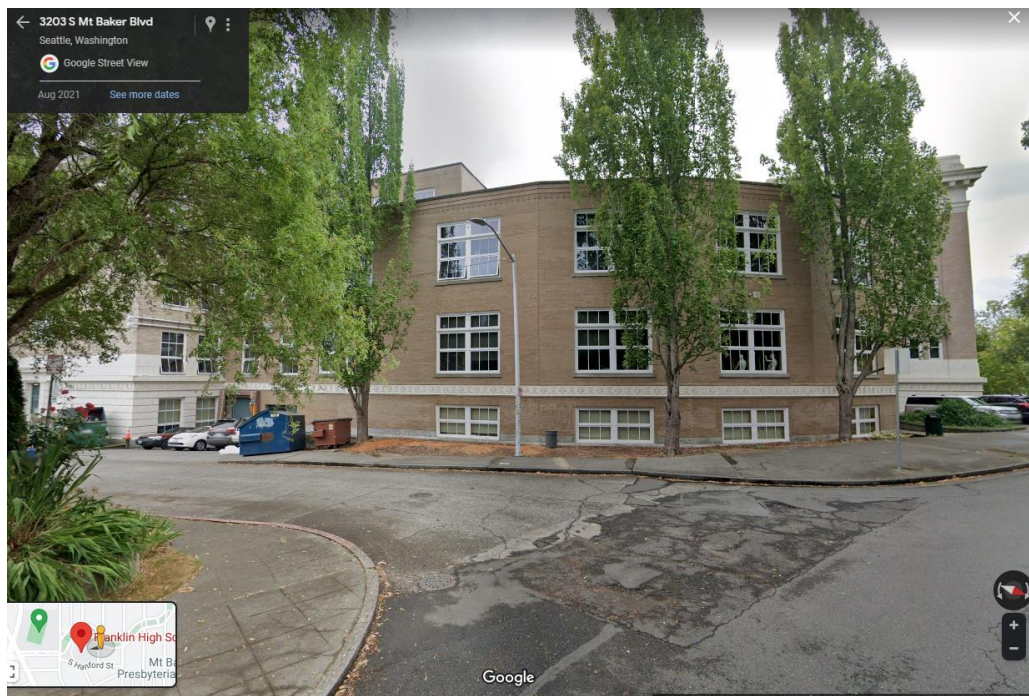
View of North face of school

Main Entrance. Observer is facing south.



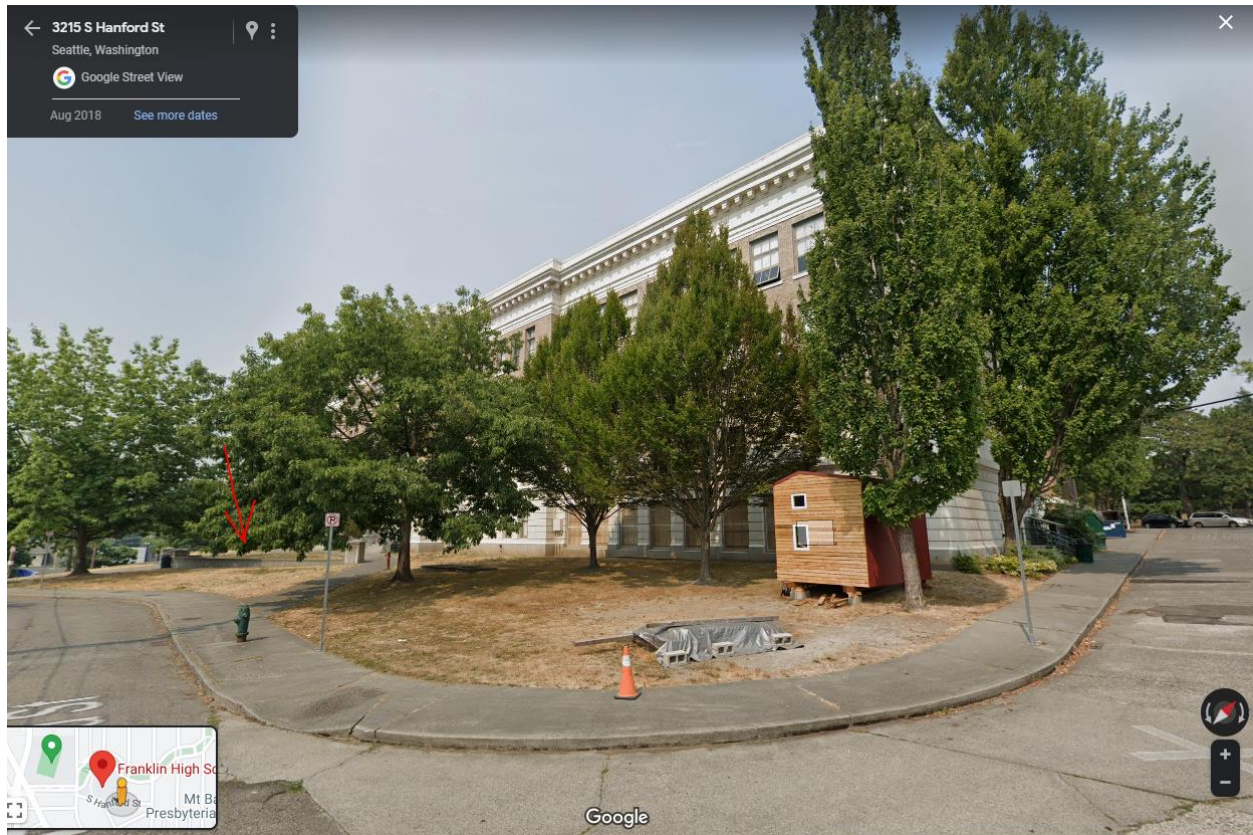
View of East side of school

The above photos are all taken from Google maps. Many of them date from 2018 and 2019 so site conditions are somewhat different.

The garden boxes will be constructed very similarly to the photos below. We require Cedar boards be utilized for construction. The garden will support student learning and growing of edible crops. This will not include any trees or permanent year round shrubby plantings.
