Name and Address of Property: Elephant Car Wash Sign — the small version sign formerly located at 6th Ave. & Battery St.

On July 6, 2022, the Seattle Landmarks Preservation Board voted to approve nomination of the subject property and scheduled a public meeting to be held on August 17, 2022.
