







Campus Map






Ca. 1925-37 views shortly after construction showing lawn and small columnar conifers along building foundation.
















*ANDERSON HALL HIGHLIGHTED IN RED AND THE FORMER FOREST PRODUCTS LABORATORY (1921) IN BLUE


