

# 2019 YVYC Funding Allocation

\$2 million of the Seattle City budget has been allocated to YVYC 2019. \$1.3 million will be divided equally among City Council districts and remaining funds will be dedicated to projects in Equity and Environment Initiative (EEI) Focus Areas. These are geographic areas where communities of color, immigrants, refugees, people with low incomes, Native peoples and limited-English proficiency individuals tend to live. Projects in EEI Focus Areas are indicated by an asterisk (\*) on the ballot.



