INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

Seattle Police Department officers responded to a disturbance between neighbors and the subject was arrested for assault. The named employee assisted the subject into the patrol vehicle.

COMPLAINT

The complainant, a supervisor within the Department, when reviewing a Use of Force video heard the subject state that she was touched in the chest and in other places that she did not want to be touched.

<u>INVESTIGATION</u>

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

- 1. Review of the complaint memo
- 2. Interview of the subject
- 3. Review of In-Car Video
- 4. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
- 5. Interviews of SPD employees

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The evidence showed that the subject did not want to be arrested and transported in a patrol vehicle. In-Car Video and witness accounts confirm that no inappropriate touching of the subject occurred, either intentionally or intentionally. The named employee is shown to have his hand on the subject's right shoulder at the same time she states that he touched her in the chest.

FINDINGS

Named Employee #1

Allegation #1

The evidence showed that the named employee did not touch the subject in an inappropriate manner. Therefore a finding of **Not Sustained** (Unfounded) was issued for *Professionalism*.
