#### **INCIDENT SYNOPSIS**

The Named Employees were on duty.

#### COMPLAINT

The complainant, a supervisor within the Department, alleged that the Named Employees failed to activate their ICV for a call they responded to.

#### **INVESTIGATION**

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

- 1. Review of the complaint memo
- 2. Review of In-Car Video (ICV)
- 3. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
- 4. Interview of SPD employee

#### ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The OPA investigation determined that Named Employee #1 never responded to or was at the scene of the incident. As a result he was not required by policy to activate his In-Car Video (ICV). OPA located Named Employee #2's ICV recording of this incident. This recording was in compliance with the policy.

#### **FINDINGS**

#### Named Employee #1

Allegation #1

The evidence showed that Named Employee #1 was not required by policy to activate his ICV as he never responded or was at the scene of the incident. Therefore a finding of **Not Sustained** (Unfounded) was issued for *In Car Video System: Employees Will Record Police Activity*.

#### Named Employee #2

#### Allegation #1

The evidence showed that Named Employee #2's ICV recording of this incident was in compliance with the policy. Therefore a finding of **Not Sustained** (Lawful and Proper) was issued for *In Car Video System: Employees Will Record Police Activity*.
