Budget	 \$2,220,000 for planning, design, and construction of the play area Including: \$500,000 from the Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program (WWRP) \$720,000 from the King County Park Levy
Project Description	This project will complete the redevelopment of Little Brook Park beginning with the design developed by community members led by Lake City Collective. This project will begin with the design proposed for the redevelopment and includes an updated play area, picnic tables and seating, a covered gathering area, a creek boardwalk, a community garden, and a restroom.
