Making a Reservation:

Lottery Applications (Email (preferred) or U.S. Mail)

Applications for the upcoming season are accepted first day of **January through the last day of February**. Beginning the 1st business day of March, applications will be processed randomly.

Applications received between March-December

We will process applications in the order received.

In Addition

We strongly recommend choosing six (6) dates and locations in case your first choice is not available.

- **Do NOT** submit duplicate requests or ask for status updates.
- We will contact you if your selections are not available.

Catering & Special Equipment Requirements

If you secure a caterer or vendor to provide on-site services or equipment, **other fees and insurance will be required.**

We define a caterer as a paid person or company that prepares, and/or serves food, or sets up equipment in a park. We define special equipment as an air-bouncer, an inflatable structure, laser tag/gaming equipment rented from or provided by a licensed business, or a canopy larger than 400 square feet, etc. All air-bounce/inflatable equipment will need a generator for power. **Seattle Parks & Recreation (SPR) does not provide electricity.**

- Requests and all changes must be made at least **14 days in advance** of your picnic.
- All vehicles need to remain in designated parking lot and park on a first-come, first-served basis. Roping or coning off parking spaces is not allowed.

Online Picnic Reservation Options:

New as of 2024, select picnic sites are reservable 5 days or more ahead of date, April-Oct. Online bookings are not considered 'standard booking's'. All bookings online are final, no exception or adjustments can be made. See locations highlighted in **blue** below for [online](#) options. All sites are reservable by application. No special equipment/requests are allowed.

This option not available for online reservations. Request must be **14 DAYS before the event date. Fees are non-transferable and all bookings must remain within the same picnic season.*

Payment Process

DO NOT submit payment with your application. A confirmation with payment instructions will be emailed to you once your application has been processed.

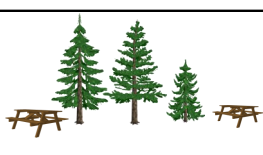
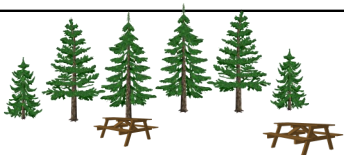
- Once payment is applied, there are **NO REFUNDS.**

Picnic Permit

- A valid permit has a \$0 balance showing. Unpaid reservations are not valid permits.
- It is your responsibility to bring the paid permit to the site on the day of your picnic to enforce your reservation.
- It is your responsibility to read, agree and abide to the terms and conditions in this brochure and the permit.
- Early arrival recommended. Minor cleaning may be needed.

Sales & Commercial Advertising

Prior permission is required for sales or commercial advertising. If approved, 10% of gross receipts collected on SPR property must be paid to the City of Seattle. Commercial advertising is allowed only with an advance payment of \$100 per surface per day.

The chart below lists parks where tables and/or shelters can be reserved. You must reserve enough tables for your party. 10 people per table **MAX**. Please provide accurate attendance.

Picnic Tables: Permanently installed, numbered tables outside of shelters are priced separately. We permit tables for up to 10 people each, most tables seat 6-10 people. **Shelter prices** will be \$5 less per seating table listed inside shelter on weekdays. Per Table Fee: **(M-F) \$15/half-day, \$25/full-day; (Sat-Sun) \$20/half-day, \$30/full-day**

Vehicle Access Not Permitted

Vehicles not allowed beyond parking lots or street.

Tents & Portable Canopies

With a picnic permit, you can set up a portable freestanding canopy measuring no more than 400 square feet (20'x20') in size. No stakes or in-ground anchors.

Clean Up & Recycle

Before leaving the park, pickup litter, debris and remove any signs, balloons or streamers from your picnic area. When using charcoal in the park, soak used coals with water and remove from the area or place in coal buckets where provided. If you find excessive litter or vandalism at your site, report it using City of Seattle's Find It, Fix It App. We appreciate your help in keeping our parks pleasant for everyone and clean for the next group.

Prohibited Activities

The following are prohibited at City parks, including all picnic areas:

- Smoking, use of illegal substances or alcoholic beverages of any kind. (SMC 18.12.255)
- Amplified sound (SMC 25.08.520)
- Fires, except fires in authorized stoves, grills, or fire rings.
- Driving on the turf/grass or in unauthorized areas.
- Driving stakes into the ground or digging holes.
- Damaging or removing anything from the park (including driftwood, shells, trees, and shrubs).
- Off-leash dogs and any dogs on beaches.

Rights & Privileges

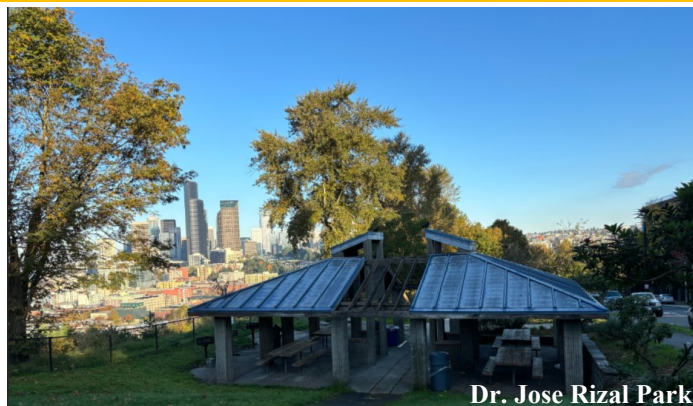
When you have obtained a picnic permit, you have the right to enjoy your picnic site for the duration of your permit. **You must bring your permit with you.** Without your permit, it's difficult to prove that you've reserved and paid for the site. ***If you arrive to your reserved site and someone is already using the space, we ask that you show them your permit, ask them to leave and allow a 30 minute period for them to relocate from your reserved space.***

Access for People with Disabilities

Within the limitations of each park site, Seattle Parks and Recreation will, at your request, do our best to make accommodations for persons with disabilities. Please arrange this through the Event Scheduling Office.

Anti-discrimination
