Getting Started

How Does Block Watch Work?

Block Watch requires two basic commitments:

- A commitment to be concerned about your neighbor's property and well-being as well as your own.
- 2. A commitment to report suspicious activity and take action by alerting your neighbors and calling 9-1-1.

How Do I Get Started?

- Think of a location for your first meeting.
 It could be your home, or a neighbors
 home, library or community center etc.
- Contact the Crime Prevention Coordinator in your area for dates and times for the coordinator to meet with you and your neighbors. seattle.gov/police/ crime-prevention/crime-preventioncoordinators
- Invite your neighbors to come it helps to invite them in person.
- The first meeting will discuss local crime trends, prevention measures and the proactive ways neighbors can work together.
- The designated Block Watch Captain will act as a primary contact for Seattle Police and communicate to the neighborhood.
