1. Visit the City of Seattle Jobs web page at www.seattle.gov/jobs and search for the Police Officer (Entry-level) July 11, 2020 exam application or click [here](#)
2. Open the exam bulletin, then click on “apply”; and
3. Follow the prompts to complete the application.

Since you already have an applicant profile it should only take you a minute or two to apply.

If the July exam time frame is not convenient, we will have another exam administered in October of 2020. The application filing period for the October exam will open on July 15, 2020 and you may apply for the October exam when the application filing period opens.
