NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING

The City of Seattle Public Safety Civil Service Commission intends to amend its Rules of Practice and Procedure adopted February 17, 2012. Pursuant to Section 3.02.030 of the Seattle Municipal Code, the Commission will take comment on the proposed amendments through 5 p.m., Friday, November 8, 2013. Comments and the amended rules will be discussed and/or voted on at the Commission's meeting on Friday, November 15, 2013.

The Rules and Amendments are authorized by Article XVI, Section 3 of the Seattle City Charter and by Subsection 4.08.070 (A) of the Seattle Municipal Code. The proposed amendments affect 2 ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATIONS; 3 DEFINITIONS; 4 RULE MAKING; 5 DISCIPLINE AND DISCHARGE; 6 HEARINGS; 7 CLASSIFICATION; 8 APPLICATIONS AND APPLICANTS; 9 EXAMINATIONS; 10 REGISTERS AND ELIGIBILITY; 11 CERTIFICATION AND APPOINTMENT; 12 PROBATION; 13 SERVICE CREDIT; 14 TRANSFER; 15 LAYOFF; 18 VETERANS; 19 RETIREMENT AND DISABILITY; 21 MISCELLANEOUS: SEVERABILITY, REPEALS AND COMPUTATION OF TIME.
