Responsibility of the Board of Administration

The Board is responsible for overseeing the management of the business and affairs of the Seattle City Employees' Retirement System (SCERS) in accordance with applicable laws. SCERS's assets are held in trust. The Board has a fiduciary responsibility for those assets. The two key fiduciary responsibilities are the duty of prudence and the duty of loyalty. The duty of prudence is largely about process and ensuring an investment process was prudent. The duty of loyalty requires the trustee to act "with an eye single to the interests of the members and beneficiaries". Please visit the Board's website for more information.
