

SEATTLE FREIGHT ADVISORY BOARD IS SEEKING NEW MEMBERS

Join the Team!

The Seattle Freight Advisory Board, created in 2010 by Seattle City Council Resolution 31243, advises the City Council, the Mayor and all departments and offices of the City on policies, plans and projects as they may relate to freight capacity, safety, access, and mobility throughout the City.

Working as a collaborative team, committed to the development and maintenance of a functional and efficient freight system within the City of Seattle, Board members will develop regular updates to the Freight Master Plan, the Freight Implementation Plan, designations of major truck streets and provide review and comment on planned projects and policies which may impact the movement of goods and services throughout the City.

Interested parties should live or work in Seattle and represent:

- Businesses, organizations, or agencies **involved** in the transport of goods and services OR
- Businesses, organizations, or agencies **that depend** on the efficient movement of goods and services within the City of Seattle.

This unpaid, volunteer position requires a commitment of two years, during which time Board members shall participate in regular monthly meetings, create letters of support or critique; provide review and comment on preliminary design plans, policies, grant applications and other freight-related items; serve as a liaison to other transportation advisory boards or otherwise as necessary; and collectively, the Freight Advisory Board will identify one representative to serve concurrently on the [Move Seattle Levy Oversight Committee](#)."

The City of Seattle is committed to promoting diversity within the City's various boards and commissions. Women, seniors, persons with disabilities, sexual minorities, and persons of color are encouraged to apply.
