

Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Construction

Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) began preparing the intersection at 16th Ave SW and SW Webster St for pedestrian safety improvements. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project and is expected to be completed November 30.

Traffic, parking and pedestrian impacts during construction:

- Parking restrictions in the work area
- Pedestrian detours around the work area
- Traffic will be maintained

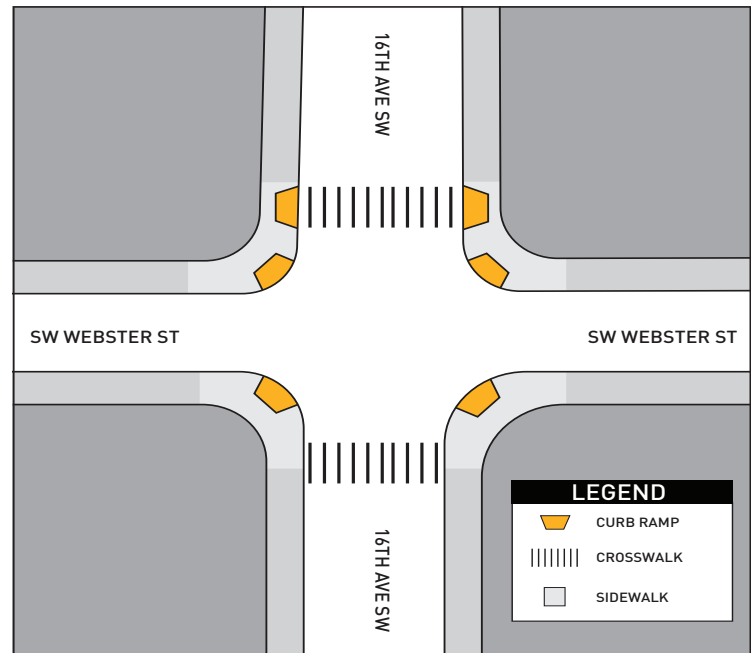
Improvements to be made at the intersection of 16th Ave SW and SW Webster St include:

- New crosswalk
- New sidewalk
- New and upgraded curb ramps

Project Information

Greenways are residential streets made safer and more comfortable for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Greenway project that will connect White Center to the West Seattle Bridge Trail. The greenway will run north-south, generally along 17th Avenue SW in the south and 21st Avenue SW in the north.

We anticipate construction completion by the end of 2015.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Weekday work hours of 7 AM to 7 PM
 - Traffic and parking restrictions
 - Intersection will remain open
 - Typical construction noise
- This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled if needed.
