### Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Construction to Begin Tuesday, September 8

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin construction of pedestrian safety improvements on SW Andover Street between 21st Avenue SW and 22nd Avenue SW on Tuesday, September 8. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Neighborhood Greenway Project and is expected to take 3-4 weeks to complete.

## Traffic, parking and pedestrian restrictions during construction:

- Flaggers will alternate two-way traffic on SW Andover Street between 21st Avenue SW and 22nd Avenue SW between 9 AM and 4 PM
- Parking restrictions in the project area
- Temporary curb ramps
- Pedestrian detours around the work area
- Stairway access to SW Andover Street will be maintained

### Improvements to be made on the north side of SW Andover Street include:

- New sidewalks
- New pedestrian railing
- New driveway entrances
- New curb and gutter
- New and upgraded curb ramps
  - Additional curb ramp upgrades at intersection of SW Andover Street and 21st Avenue SW

#### **Project Information**

Greenways are residential streets made safer and more comfortable for people of all ages and abilities to walk and ride bikes. This work is part of the Delridge-Highland Park Greenway project that will connect White Center to the West Seattle Bridge Trail. The greenway will run north-south, generally along 17th Avenue SW in the south and 21st Avenue SW in the north.

We anticipate that construction of the greenway will be complete by the end of the year.
